To outline the possibilities for workers and lifelong learners by developing VET programs delivering specific modules to prepare students for HE by offering bridge courses and taking work experience/training into consideration.

To outline the transferability between Higher Vocational Education and Training (HVET) to Short Cycle Higher Education (SCHE) and from HVET or SCHE to Bachelor's programs through a clear and coherent credit transfer system.
